

MINUTES
DES PERES BOARD OF ALDERMEN
August 22, 2016
DES PERES GOVERNMENT CENTER

The regular meeting of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Des Peres, Missouri was held at the Des Peres Government Center, 12325 Manchester Road commencing at 7:00 PM on Monday, August 22, 2016.

ROLL CALL

The City Clerk took roll with the following board members present: Alderman Gmelich, Alderman Pound, Alderman Raczkiwicz, Alderman Kleinschmidt, Alderman Concagh and Alderman Becker.

Mayor Lahr introduced and welcomed Scott Schaefer as the new Assistant City Administrator.

Staff members present included: City Administrator, City Attorney, City Clerk, Assistant City Administrator, Director of Public Works, Director of Public Safety, Director of Finance and the Director of Parks and Recreation. At this time the Board of Aldermen, staff and citizens rose for the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Mayor Lahr announced the first item of business was a public hearing on the Petition of The Village Bar for approval of a Master Site Plan and Conditional Use Permit to Allow for Expansion of the Dining Area at The Village; Construction of an outside patio; and conversion of the barn into an outdoor dining special event pavilion.

Mark Disper and Chuck Kirberg, owners of The Village Bar, were present and gave an overview of the proposed site plan. Mr. Disper stated the hours of operation will remain the except for the restaurant will be open on Sundays during football season. He further stated the restaurant met the city's parking standards and that the chain linked fence behind the property will be repaired.

Alderman Gmelich asked how the barn space would be utilized for special events and expressed concern regarding large crowds gathering outside of the barn.

Mr. Disper responded the barn space would be limited to 50 people and would only be used if reserved for a private event.

Alderman Concagh asked if the restaurant would expand in to the space formerly leased by The Custom Wig Shop.

Mr. Disper responded the space previously leased by The Custom Wig Shop is now leased by a Certified Public Accountant.

Hearing no further comments or questions, Mayor Lahr closed the public hearing.

Mayor Lahr announced the second item of business was a public hearing on the Petition of Rib City for a Temporary Outside Storage and Display Permit for a Community Event on the Parking Lot on September 17, 2016

Greg Matthes, owner of Rib City, stated the event will be held on the parking lot in front of Rib City and will include a small band. He further stated the hours of the event had changed and the event would begin at 6:00 p.m. and conclude at 9:00 p.m.

Hearing no further comments or questions, Mayor Lahr closed the public hearing.

AMENDMENT OF AGENDA

Mayor Lahr asked if there were any additions or changes to the agenda. None were requested.

CITIZEN COMMENTS AND PETITIONS

Bob Ashcraft, 1543 Fawnvalley, stated he would like to see the traffic study related to Reliance Bank and Starbucks include an analysis of right ingress and right egress from Manchester Road.

Mayor Lahr stated previous studies had included this information and that a cut thru area would be available behind the Regions Bank development so that residents in the area would have access to a traffic signal.

REPORTS OF OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES

The Mayor indicated that there were written reports submitted from the Public Safety Commission Meeting of August 1, 2016; the Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting of August 4, 2016; and the Planning and Zoning Commission Meeting of August 10, 2016.

Mayor Lahr advised that the Consent Agenda consists of eight (8) items.
