ROLL CALL

Commissioner Chair Beermann opened the meeting. Administrative Assistant Llorián commenced with the roll call. There was a quorum with Chief Krumm absent due to medical leave.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

ALDERMANIC REPORT

Alderman Fitzpatrick asked if the Commission had any Aldermanic questions.

BUDGET

Acting Chief Quinn stated the department budget is on course for the exception of in building maintenance and first aid supplies. He concluded that adjustments will be made in those categories.

NEW BUSINESS

Introduction of Newly Promoted Sergeant

Acting Chief Quinn announced the promotion of PSO Brett Zolla to sergeant. Sergeant Zolla and his family were present to pin his new badge and a small reception followed the meeting.

Election of Chairperson for Public Safety Commission

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to elect Commissioner Beermann as chairperson for the Public Safety Commission. Commissioner Lund seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

Resident Camera Program

Acting Chief Quinn asked the commission if they had any questions regarding the resident camera program. He conclude that Commission will vote on whether to implement the program in December 2018.

Insurance Services Office Audit for 2018

Captain Hall stated that the ISO Audit went very well. He stated he has no concerns that the department's rating will improve. He concluded that he will have binders from the audit to pass out at the next meeting.

Commissioner Sullivan complimented Captain Hal for all his hard work and for how smoothly the audit went.

CALEA Update

Lt. Willoughby stated that the refrigeration for the evidence locker arrived and will be installed. He stated that he will be working with Arch to get the evidence lockers ready. He added that there has been some delays with receiving the recorders in time. Captain Hall added that the city has been having difficulty dealing with the vendor in order to get the recorder shipped. Lt. Willoughby concluded that the assessors will in the building on November 27th.

DISCUSSION

Acting Chief Quinn stated that St. Louis Night Out is October 2nd. He added that depending on budget meetings the regular October 1st Public Safety Commission will not be held in lieu of participating in the National Night Out. He concluded that decision to hold the October 1st meeting will be determined later in the month.

Commissioner Ashcraft stated that the out of town resident request is up and working. He inquired about a fire and incident that occurred at the West County Center parking garage. He also asked if the department was familiar with the Siren GPS app and there was any plans to utilize it. Captain Hall stated that the department is in discussions with Kirkwood about jointly purchasing the app for cost reasons.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Lund seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:24 p.m.
